Artwork and Tutorial

Tip: It is possible to get 10 ATCs from one 8.5" by 11" piece of paper by cutting the paper long ways at 2.5" and 5". The 2.5" wide strips get cut again at 3.5" intervals and the 3.5" strip gets cut again at 2.5" intervals.

Step 1 Cut black cardstock to 2.5" by 3.5" - standard ATC size.

Step 2 Cut O'So Sticky Tape™ sheet 2.5" by 3.5" - standard ATC size



Step 3

The secret to applying O'So Sticky Tape™ perfectly every time is to peel back just one small corner of the tape sheet to begin with as pictured. Next, with the fold facing down towards your cardstock base begin to align the O'So Sticky Tape™ sheet to fit squarely. The folded flap will keep the O'So from actually touching your paper.

Step 4

Once the tape is lined up with the base press firmly on the exposed corner to anchor the O'So Sticky in place. Next remove the rest of the liner from the back of the tape and gently smooth it into place as you go.



Step 5

Now peel the top liner from the O'So Sticky Tape™ and place it back on your ATC base in the corner to use as a "handle". (See photo) This will allow you to easily move and manipulate your artwork without touching the exposed tape.



Step 6

Tear a piece or two of marbled or decorative paper and place at random on your ATC. It is not necessary to try to line up the edges with your base, the card will be trimmed later.

Tip: Use the red tape liner sheet instead of your fingers to press down on the edges of the decorative paper.

Step 7

Select the collage sheet image that you wish to use and cut it out from the sheet. You can use this image as is, or you may choose to add a complementary piece of background paper to the image. (Examples showing both ways can be found at the top of this tutorial) When working with collage sheets it is not necessary to worry about perfectly straight cuts, it's collage after all! Just use scissors and free cut your image and if you wish to mount it on colored paper, just apply the image to the paper with 3M™ ATG or other adhesive and then cut around the edges with your scissors or even tear one edge.

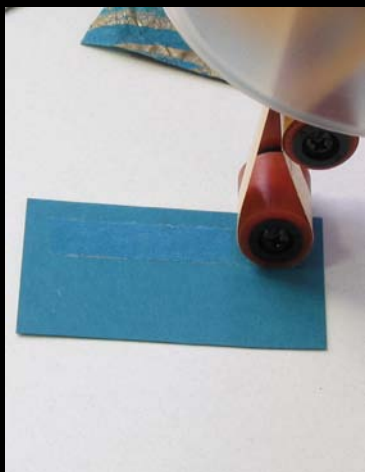

Step 8

Apply 3M™ ATG adhesive to the back of the image to ensure that it sticks well to your collage.



Step 9

Place the image at random on the ATC base. It is desirable to leave some open spaces of tape which will be filled in soon.



Step 10

Add a strip or two of metallic string to the exposed O'So Sticky Tape™ on the ATC card. Frazzle the edges of the string if desired.



Step 11

Turn the ATC card over and from the back side trim the excess decorative paper and metallic string from the edges.



Step 12

Press the ATC into the micro bead mixture to fill in any exposed tape areas. Use your fingers and press firmly on the beads to ensure that they are well seated into the O'So Sticky Tape™

Step 13

Select a word or phrase from the word collage sheet to finish off the design. Apply with a 1/4" strip of O'So Sticky Tape™ or your favorite adhesive. Protect your artwork with a plastic ATC sleeve.
